VINEGAR SOAKS

In some situations we use a vinegar solution soak prior to bandage changes. This soak will act as an antibiotic as the vinegar solution is a deterrent to certain bacterial growth.

Recipe:

- 1. Boil one (1) quart of water.
- 2. Add ½ cup of white vinegar.
- 3. Let cool until warm.
- 4. Place vinegar solution in a clean jar which has been washed in a dishwasher.
- 5. The vinegar solution may be stored in the refrigerator and re-warmed before each use.

Dressing change once daily:

- 1. Wash area with soap and water.
- 2. Wet a clean gauze or cotton ball with the vinegar solution and apply to wound for 10 minutes.
- 3. Clean wound with a Q-tip® and apply the dressing as instructed on the wound care instruction sheet.
