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## Highlights of Dr. Sago's Presentation at the Luau-N- Learn Event

During our Luau-N-Learn event, Dr. Joni Sago answered important questions and addressed common concerns about sunscreens and sun safety. Here are some of the highlights from her presentation.

Look for sunscreens that contain zinc oxide and/or titanium dioxide because these ingredients *reflect* rather than *absorb* sun rays. These ingredients are safer to use during pregnancy and for infants older than six months.

Specific concerns regarding the sunscreen ingredient oxybenzone were addressed. Studies of this ingredient are limited and were performed on animals. However, look for products that contain less than 6% oxybenzone and avoid the ingredient during pregnancy and for infants.

Higher numbered SPF (like 80 or 100) are misleading and give a false sense of security. Usually, these high numbered sunscreens are applied too thinly and are not re-applied often enough. Sunscreens with SPF of 15 can effectively block 93% of UVB rays if applied liberally and re-applied often.

Sunscreen should be applied 30 minutes before you plan on being in the sunlight.

Avoiding sun exposure from 10 am until 2-3 pm (during peak hours) is an important way to protect your skin from sun damage.

Wearing sun protective clothing and using a laundry SPF additive (like SunGuard™) are two easy tips for those who are resistant to wearing sunscreen. However, the sun protection will be limited to only the areas covered by the clothing and sunscreen should still be applied to uncovered areas.
